The Language Centre of the University of Cyprus is a partner in the European programme Vocational Technology Enhanced Learning (VocTEL). VocTEL is a Lifelong Learning programme, Leonardo da Vinci Transfer of Innovation. The focus of the project is the adaptation of a postgraduate online programme in Technology Enhanced Learning (TEL) specifically for the Vocational Education and Training (VET) sector. The project commenced on 1st October 2013 and the first meeting took place at the University of Wales Trinity Saint David. The partner countries participating in the programme are Bulgaria, Cyprus, Greece, Sweden and the UK. The contact person for the programme for Cyprus is Mrs Shauna Joannidou.

VocTEL is a one year fully funded EU programme which upon successful completion participants will be awarded a Post-Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) in TEL. Participants have the option to continue on to year two and three

(which will be self-funded) and upon successful completion receive an MA-TEL degree from the University of Wales Trinity Saint David.

This programme is for participants involved in professional development in public and private organizations and adult education trainers active in different fields, i.e. business, tourism, medicine, etc.

The Language Centre welcomes participation from Cyprus for VocTEL. The deadline for applications is August 15, 2014.
