## short biography



Professor Angus Deaton is the Dwight D. Eisenhower Professor of Economics and International Affairs at the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs and the Economics Department at Princeton University. His main current research areas

are in health, wellbeing, and economic development. He is a corresponding Fellow of the British Academy, a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and of the Econometric Society and, in 1978, was the first recipient of the Society's Frisch Medal. He was the President of the American Economic Association in 2009. His current research focuses on the determinants of health and wellbeing in rich and poor countries, as well as on the measurement of poverty in India and around the world, while he also maintains a long-standing interest in the analysis of household surveys.
