The Department of Physics, University of Cyprus, announces one full-time position (140 hours / month): The selected candidate will take responsibility for managing and supporting the implementation of the European Joint Doctorate program Advanced computing, quantum algorithms, and data-driven approaches for science, technology and engineering (AQTIVATE) as well as partly be involved in monitoring and helping in the preparation of future EU Marie Skłodowska-Curie proposals.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- A PhD degree in Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science, Engineering, or any other relevant field
- Previous experience in a research/academic institution
- Experience with presentations at conferences and workshops
- Publications in conference proceedings or journals
- Strong scientific and technical writing skills
- High level of communication and interpersonal skills
- High-level organizational, analytical and problem-solving skills
- Ability to multitask and change priorities with limited supervision
- Experience in presenting to medium and large audiences
- Knowledge of computational methods

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will be carrying out the following activities

- Project administration/coordination/management (financial reporting, deliverables, communication with funding organizations)
- Preparation of meetings and communication with the partners in the project and the fellows.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

The duration of employment will be 4 years with the possibility of renewal. The monthly gross earnings amount to €2,916 to €4,166. From this amount employee contributions shall be deducted. There is no provision for 13th salary.
