context of Open Science and its place in the new European Research Area and the challenges for Open Science in Higher Education Institutions. She identified the main problems to practically implementing Open Science and ended her speech by saying that "Science is like a parachute... if it is not open, it will not help us".

The occasion also included five meetings focused on the working areas of the project, a Management Committee meeting to discuss strategic dimensions of the project, and a

discussion with representatives from the Knowledge Transfer Expert Network of the YUFE Alliance.

Lastly a joint meeting between the Advisory Board and the Management Committee of the Project took place. The Vice-Rectors and the Experts on Research & Innovation from the YUFE alliance Universities that comprise the Advisory Board learned more about the achievements of this project and the upcoming work.
